

Peking Pavilion, a prominent central New Jersey Asian restaurant, was destroyed by fire in Christmas of 2004. Penn Valley Constructors began construction on the new building in October 2006. The new restaurant features an expanded kitchen service, a mezzanine level for private dining and a distinctive entry portal designed to have the look of a Corian finish.


